enal Issues keeps our readers regularly informed of the results of some of the research done at the CESDIP, as well as of publications by members of our team. This information is incomplete, however, and does not reflect the entire range of research under way. The object of the present issue is to correct this shortcoming. It is published at a very important time in the life of the Center, on two counts.

We have in fact just celebrated the 30th anniversary of its creation, by a major conference held on October 14 to 16, 1999 at the headquarters of the CNRS, on the theme "Normative systems, deviance and social control. New stakes, new approaches". Some fifty-odd papers were delivered at the meeting, which was attended by about 150 participants, around four main themes : the question of the spaces in which regulations and deviance take place; the question of changes in the articulation between different levels (local, national and transnational) at which power is exerted, with the redefinition of the public and private spheres of social life, or again, the changing relations between the judicial and the political; the effects of these changes on relations between individuals and between social groups and in their perception of them; last, the analysis of urban violence, viewed from the angle of the emergence, the redefinition and the compartmentalization of cultures and identities, and their relations with the society around them, rather than through the angle of crime and public order maintenance. Furthermore, the traditional four-year evaluation of the CESDIP activities by the CNRS took place during the fourth quarter of 1999. The pursuit of the collaboration between the ministry of Justice and the CNRS hinges on this evaluation. This provides an opportunity for the entire team to assess the activities of the past four years, and to present its program for the coming four vears.
